Executive Vice President And Chief Technology Officer Circle K Stores Inc.

ORBIE Leadership Award recipient: Transforming the customer experience

When Ed Dzadovsky turned 16, his father said what many parents of 16-year-olds do, "If you want to drive a car, you need to get a job."

So Dzadovsky set off in search of part-time work, landing a role at a McDonald's restaurant in his hometown of Pittsburgh. He didn't realize he was getting more than pocket money to cover his car, insurance and gas; he was starting a lifelong career.

"I loved working at McDonald's," Dzadovsky said. "I didn't think I would love it, but I did, and this curiosity on the tech side of me was always thinking about how I could use technology to help make the store experience better."

Throughout high school and college, Dzadovsky worked as a crew person and, later, a shift manager. After graduating with a computer science degree from the University of Pittsburgh, he moved into his first technology role as a regional store systems specialist.

"I went from an \$8-an-hour store manager to a salaried technology professional for a business unit," he said. "I loved operations, and I loved technology. To be able to put those two things together and deliver solutions that made a difference for people was really cool."

A few decades later, Dzadovsky is the Leadership Award recipient in ArizonaClO's 2023 Arizona ClO of the Year ORBIE Awards. The program honors executives who demonstrate excellence in technology leadership, drive innovation and transform Arizona's leading organizations.

Dzadovsky spent 25 years at McDonald's, moving up to senior director IT delivery of global digital products. In that role, he led initiatives to roll out mobile order, payment and offers systems to the fast-food chain's top 20,000 restaurants.

When the opportunity to lead another digital transformation came up five years ago, this time at Tempe-based Circle K Stores Inc., he jumped at the chance. Today, Dzadovsky serves as executive vice president and chief technology officer for Circle K, which operates more than 14,000 convenience and fuel stores worldwide.

Through Dzadovsky's leadership, Circle K has become a leader in innovation and technology in the convenience and fuel store industry. The company has implemented human resources and labor management applications to make things easier for store associates; introduced smart checkout, which uses computer vision and Al for fast checkout; and explored options such as frictionless stores and gas pumps.

"We like to say at Circle K, we're making it easier for our customers and our employees," Dzadovsky said. "And that (goal has) always been something that resonated with me, even as a 16-year-old employee."

However, this effort has not come without its challenges. Circle K is owned by Alimentation Couche-Tard, based in Quebec, Canada. It has grown through a robust series of mergers and acquisitions, which led to significant technical debt as each newly acquired business brought a unique set of point-of-sale systems, enterprise resource planning software and data centers.

At one point, the company had 44 combinations of its retail systems in North America alone. Dzadovsky and his team introduced the rallying cry #44istoomany.

"The number isn't 44 today; it's closer to 15," he said. "We found a way to abstract that complexity that enables us to do fun things like smart

checkout or a loyalty platform without having to do all of those configurations."

The technology team at Circle K includes 600 to 700 full-time employees distributed throughout the world. Dzadovsky encourages emerging leaders to combine their technical expertise with operational skills that allow them to use technology to deliver business results.

"We're not just looking for a coder to come in and deliver an application," he said. "We want somebody who is going to deliver an experience that makes it easy for our customers and for our employees."

That customer-centric focus is critical across the technology profession, Dzadovsky said.

"The CIO, the CTO and the tech teams were some of the heroes of Covid," he said. "They enabled an entirely remote workforce in record time, in a secure fashion. Organization after organization continually talked about how tech stepped up and delivered."

In today's environment, with businesses facing inflation, wage pressure, talent shortages and other economic headwinds, technologists need to step up again in a different way. "We've got to face that next frontier," Dzadovsky said. "When in doubt, you always go back to the center, which is a customer, and start working out from there."

Since retirement I have been fortunate to mentor and advise several young companies in the areas of product development, go-to-market strategy and communication.
