Central Texas ORBIE Leadership Award recipient Stephen Elkins on generative AI and why it will be transformative for government agencies

Stephen Elkins spent 16 years in senior management at semiconductor manufacturer Applied Materials before joining the City of Austin as in 2003 and became chief information officer in 2010. He spent 10 years implementing the city's information technology strategies, including making sure teams were connected and data security was prioritized during the first year of the pandemic.

In the fall of 2020, he took a job at Microsoft as the client director for Texas for state and local government.

"Microsoft's mission is to empower every person and every organization on the planet to achieve more," Elkins said. "This is exactly what my team and myself focus on when interacting with our customers. This includes solving problems and achieving goals."

Elkins also serves on the board of the Samaritan Center, the Salvation Army, the Greater Austin Black Chamber of Commerce and the Austin chapter of the Society of Information Management.

As part of this year's 2023 Central Texas ORBIE Awards, Elkins spoke with the Austin Business Journal about some key technology topics. He is this year's Leadership Award recipient.

Top IT traits

Today's technology leaders should demonstrate skills that go beyond knowledge of the latest technologies. Developing skills tied to organizational goals can help these leaders better support the overall business.

"What has helped me is that I understood IT was a support organization that helped others with their business goals and objectives," Elkins said. "I would add – listen more and talk less; IT leaders need to understand the customer's vision and line of business, which will help them to be a better partner."

IT leadership was critical during the pandemic as companies had use technology to quickly pivot to remote work. These leaders also were responsible for ensuring that sensitive data could be protected outside of the traditional office environment.

IT leaders can leverage their growing stature to help their organizations meet evolving employee, consumer and stakeholder expectations.

"IT leaders need to partner with business leaders to create a clear message on how to meet the needs for employees, consumers and stakeholders," Elkins said. "IT cannot operate in a vacuum. By working jointly, you get the business perspective (the what) as well as the technical perspective (the how)."

Top opportunities

There are opportunities on the horizon for IT leaders as technologies like artificial intelligence, the metaverse and the cloud continue to open up new possibilities for business efficiencies and interactions with clients, citizens and organizational partners.

Elkins has his eye particularly on generative AI, a technology that can produce several different kinds of creative content such as text, imagery, voice, audio and synthetic data. A recent report from Bloomberg Intelligence, in fact, found that generative AI could grow to a \$1.3 trillion market over the next 10 years, from a market size of just \$40 billion in 2022.

In Elkins' line of work, Microsoft reports that advanced Al has the potential to revolutionize how the public sector addresses challenges. The technology has a host of implications for government entities and will impact citizen services, internal efficiencies and insights into "deep data," while also serving as a creative aid for employees.

"Generative AI will be transformational once it takes off," Elkins said. "The use cases are unlimited. There will always be more work than people at government agencies, so government needs to leverage technology to improve delivery of services to its residents/citizens. Generative AI is a tool to do just that."


