Security is top of mind for every leader and organization, and the same principles that have served ClOs can be applied to ClSOs as well.



2023 KEYNOTE

Ralph Loura

SVP & CIO, Lumentum (ret)



How CIOs can shape sustainable technology and cultivate the next generation of leaders

Ralph Loura has always enjoyed a challenge. In fact, his career as an IT executive charted its course when he solved a departmental problem while working at Bell Labs as a programmer. Fresh out of college in the mid-1980s and frustrated over long queues and batch processing, he kept pestering the boss about getting those "new computers called workstations" into the department.

"I think he bought us three workstations just to shut me up," Loura said. "He told me, 'If you think you can make it better, go make it better.' And we did." Within six to eight months, the department was humming along with an easier and more user-centric experience thanks to Loura.

That experience cemented his path of fixing IT problems and creating solutions. "I really enjoyed delivering something that people used," Loura said. "I stumbled into it accidentally and never turned back."

Now semiretired from a long career in IT leadership at iconic brands such as Hewlett-Packard, Clorox and most recently as senior vice president and chief information officer of San Jose-based Lumentum (NASDAQ: LITE), Loura serves on several advisory boards and is chairman of SustainablelT.org, a nonprofit working to advance global sustainability through technology leadership. Recently, he was asked to share some of the lessons he learned during his career as a keynote speaker at the Bay Area ORBIE Awards event.

One of those lessons, Loura said, is the value of planning for, and celebrating, failure. It is a lesson he said can be taken from IT architectures that include network or server software redundancies. "We plan for some of those components to fail," he said. "And if you're pushing the envelope and trying new things, you're not always going to have an on-budget success rate. So, we plan for that."

Failing well isn't easy, Loura said, especially for capable people who are successful and thoughtful. But it will happen, so "plan for it. Find ways to celebrate in an appropriate way."

When looking to the future of the technology industry, especially at the executive leadership level, Loura is concerned about the talent pipeline and what he sees as an unexpected outcome from a prior solution. "A couple of decades ago," he said, "we started outsourcing a lot of lower-level tasks and jobs to offshore vendors. This was fine and addressed a number of problems."

But now, Loura stressed, the industry is lacking seasoned and experienced people for executive-level roles because the people with 15 years of experience running networks were outsourced. "We narrowed our talent pipeline dramatically," he said. "We need to be thoughtful about where our next set of experienced leaders come from. It might take a generation to get those leaders back here. You can bring the building back, you can even hire operators to run the factory floor, but it's really hard to bring back a generation of knowledge to run a very complex silicon reactor, for example."

In his role as chairman of SustainablelT.org, Loura leads 25 ClOs active in the environmental, social and business governance (ESG) arena. Many companies are handed ESG initiatives from their CEO or investors, but Loura wants to broaden the role ClOs play within the space beyond "creating a quarterly dashboard that keeps track of carbon credits."

"The CIOs bring to us what their companies are doing," he said, "how they're leaning in, how they're trying to be different and innovative." The group has just published a cohesive set of standards for sustainability, from an IT standpoint, that encourage broader thinking about sustainability that includes looking at the rates of laptop and phone re-purchases and other technology issues.

The organization will also be conducting training and possibly offering certification for sustainable IT practitioners. "We really want to up the dialogue in order to move us down that maturity curve faster than we've done in other transitions, like the digital transformation," Loura said.

In addition to the advisory boards and his chairman role at SustainablelT.org, Loura also finds time for one-on-one mentoring, providing guidance to that next generation of leaders.

His advice is straightforward. "If you want a seat at the table, pull up a chair," he said. "Have a point of view and add value. Spend time with your business partners, understand their pain points. Think about how to use technology to help them and pretty soon they won't let you leave the room."

Rajat Taneja

Leadership recipient Rajat Taneja on keeping the future in view

While an engineering student at Jadavpur University in West Bengal, India, Rajat Taneja studied the complicated scientific computer language known as Fortran. Released in the late 1950s, it is the oldest programming language still in use due to its flexibility in evolving for computationally intensive applications. Taneja says coming to understand the profound power of software to make his role as an engineer more impactful was transformational. He was hooked.

Today, after decades working in cutting-edge technology, Taneja said, "Once I started working, I felt like I would do this even if no one paid me. It's so gratifying and so much fun, too."

Taneja's professional career has provided him with outstanding opportunities during a robust time in technological development. He joined Microsoft in 1996 and, for the next 15 years, was involved with the company's biggest and best products, including Xbox Live, Office product expansions including the precursor to today's Office 365 and Bing ad platform and commercial search engine. His last role was as corporate vice president of the commerce division, which was part of the Azure organization.

Taneja next had a brief stint at gaming company Electronic Arts, serving as chief technology officer before joining Visa as the president of

technology. Now in his 10th year at Visa, Taneja is as excited about his work as he's ever been. "Technology has evolved so dramatically over the course of my career that it has enabled all of us in the field to do tremendous, impactful, purposeful and meaningful work," he said. "I feel more optimistic today about the future than when I first began."

Taneja leads the technology team at Visa, which will number nearly 14,000 people by the end of 2023. "I've never been in an environment where there is so much commitment and passion and client obsession," he said. "It's a large team, but it's also a very special team. I feel like it's one of those teams where the whole is much greater than the sum of the parts."

Taneja is the Leadership Award winner as part of the 2023 Bay Area ORBIE Awards. The award honors technology executives who exhibit leadership, create business value through innovation and are active in industry and community efforts.

Innovation is a key driver at Visa, according to Taneja. In fact, the company pioneered the use of Al models in payments 30 years ago and recently celebrated this 30-year milestone. Not content to rely on past success, Taneja's focus is on creating value for the next generation. "Ten years ago, we realized Al is going to accelerate, so we built our own Al data platform which allows us to

embrace Al for the future," he said.

What's the next big concern for evolving tech? According to Taneja, it's the hacking ability that bad actors will acquire with the development of quantum computing. Because of its unimaginable speed and processing capabilities, QC poses a significant threat to traditional encryption algorithms like RSA and ECC by solving their underlying mathematical problems exponentially faster, something Visa cannot let happen. This is an area of important research in Taneja's team, which is also working closely with standards organizations and other companies to prevent this with new standards and quantum safe security infrastructure.

"Our obsession with our clients means our cybersecurity has to be job No. 1 for all of us," he said. "We run such a large part of the personal consumption economy that we've invented many products to secure our infrastructure from breach. We have to get ahead in the use and practice of quantum computing."

Visa is celebrating its 65th year in business, a milestone which Taneja says puts his award in perspective. "This is an honor," he said, "but the honor reflects the team at Visa, not just now but in the past. It honors the people on whose shoulders we stand who did incredible work before us and our whole team."
