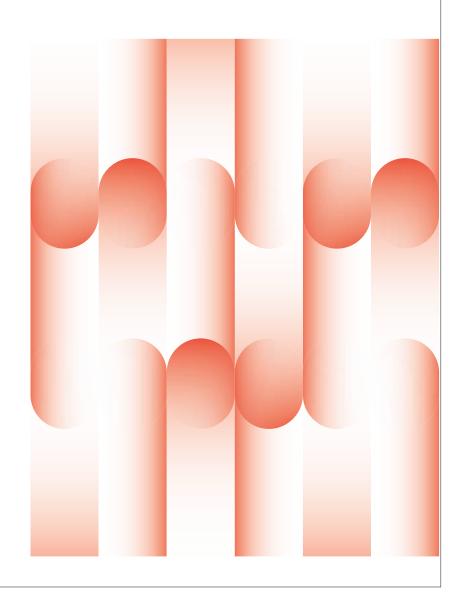

Tom Leighton

Co-Founder, Chief Executive Officer | Akamai Technologies

Boston ORBIE Leadership Award recipient on nurturing students in STEM





The person who solved the "World Wide Wait" is someone who has been hailed as one of the top inventors of our time. Tom Leighton, a computer scientist who co-founded Akamai Technologies in 1998, is recognized as a global authority on algorithms for network applications and cybersecurity. In short, he figured out how to deliver content to billions of internet users quickly and securely — and that's only a tiny fraction of his accomplishments.

This year's Leadership Award recipient for the Boston ORBIE Awards holds more than 50 patents for content delivery, internet protocols, network algorithms, cryptography and digital rights management. Leighton and Akamai co-founder Danny Lewin were inducted into the National Inventors Hall of Fame in 2017 for inventing "the methods needed to intelligently replicate and deliver content over a large network of distributed servers."

Leighton has grown Akamai into the leading global distributed cloud platform with sought-after solutions for content delivery, cybersecurity and cloud computing. During his tenure as CEO, which began in 2013, the company's revenue more than doubled to \$3.6 billion in 2022, and earnings per share nearly tripled.

Making math for everyone

Above and beyond his scientific achievements, Leighton has spent a career nurturing students in STEM fields. He has been a mathematics professor at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology since 1989 (he's currently on leave but still teaches one class, Mathematics for Computer Science, every other academic year). He led the creation of the Akamai Technical Academy aimed at preparing diverse non-technical professionals for new careers in tech. Leighton's charitable support includes organizations furthering STEM education and career opportunities including the Center for Excellence in Education, Society for Science, Mathematical Association of America, Math Competition for Girls and Girls Who Code.

"Math education in K-12, especially for girls and underrepresented groups, is probably one of the most neglected things out there and probably one of the most important," Leighton told the Boston Business Journal during a November 2022 podcast interview.

"I have a son and a daughter, both are talented at

mathematics and interested in mathematics, and the social pressures on the girls (by) about seventh or eighth grade are brutal. My daughter was the only girl on the math team, and she was the best member of the team. But ultimately, the pressures got so large that she stopped doing it when she got to high school."

How to create a great employee culture

Amid the Great Resignation and higher attrition, caring about one another goes a long way toward keeping employees engaged in the growth mindset, Leighton said during the podcast.

"Inclusiveness is so important for us," he said. "With a team getting everybody's input, sometimes you could argue that, 'Hey, consensus is too hard to do, slows you down.' There are certain cultures where maybe you don't do that. You think of a military culture and that's a very top-down, command-driven, and ... maybe that's good in that environment. (Akamai's) culture is not that way. People like to be engaged.

"I find ... you get where you want to go faster if you have everybody contribute their best ideas. You make a better decision, and then people are engaged in moving forward to go get the goal."

Flexibility around where you work is also critical, Leighton said. "We've been pretty clear from the start at Akamai that we're going to enable at least 95%, maybe 97%, of our employees to work where they want, so they can come in (to an office) or not," he said.

The dynamic has forced a great shift not only for Akamai but for the cities where it has offices. In Bangalore, India, employees have left the city to return to their hometowns to be with their families. San Francisco has seen a marked decline, with employees moving elsewhere. In Boston, the trend has played out to a lesser extent, Leighton said

"Now, we're looking at how do you ... bring people together on occasion?" he said. "Because the human contact is an important part of culture. It's where we're finding our way, but we're going to err on the side of letting the employees decide for themselves and enabling them to be productive wherever they decide to be."

The next giant technology shift

Leighton, who worked down the hall at MIT from World Wide Web inventor Tim Berners-Lee, says "some flavor of the metaverse" could spark the next wave of disruptive evolution in the way mankind uses technology. Generative AI could also be poised to enable a major leap forward.

"If we're speaking more broadly, I think my guess is genetic engineering to cure disease and aging," he said. "There are just tremendous advances there. It's a very computational problem. My guess is that at some point, that gets figured out. I don't know how long it'll take to do, but it's amazing the capabilities that we already have."

Leighton holds a Bachelor of Science degree in electrical engineering and computer science from Princeton University and a Ph.D. in applied mathematics from MIT.

His awards and honors are numerous:

- John von Neumann Medal from the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers in 2023.
- Marconi Prize from the Marconi Society in 2018.
- Elected as ACM Fellow in 2018.
- Inducted into the National Inventors Hall of Fame in 2017.
- Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
- Fellow of the American Mathematical Society.
- Member of the United States National Academy of Sciences.
- Member of the National Academy of Engineering.
- Charles Babbage Award from the IEEE Computer Society.
- Inaugural winner of the Machtey Award.

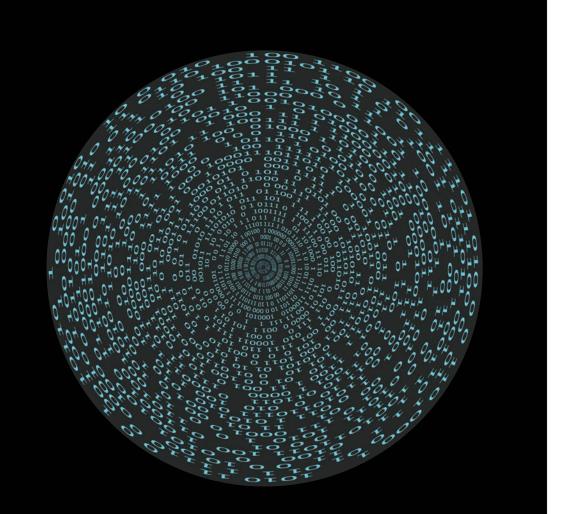
Leighton served on the president's Information Technology Advisory Committee and chaired its subcommittee on cybersecurity. He serves on the board of trustees of the Society for Science and of the Center for Excellence in Education (CEE), and he has participated in the Distinguished Lecture Series at the Research Science Institute, the CEE's program for high school students.

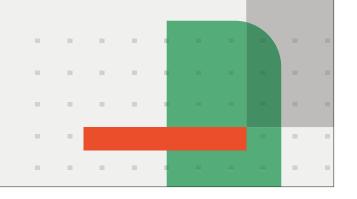

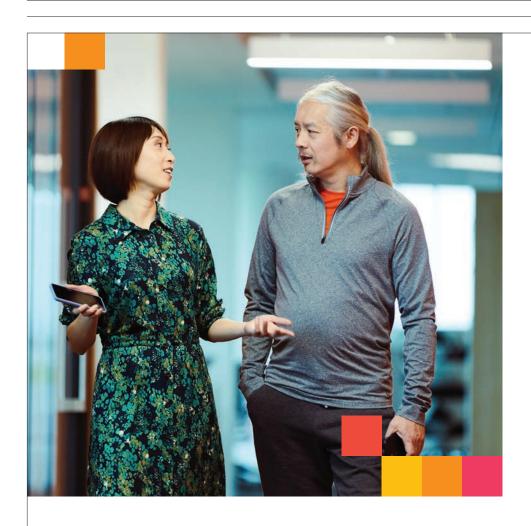

We only lost two team members and gained nine new people since the pandemic began.

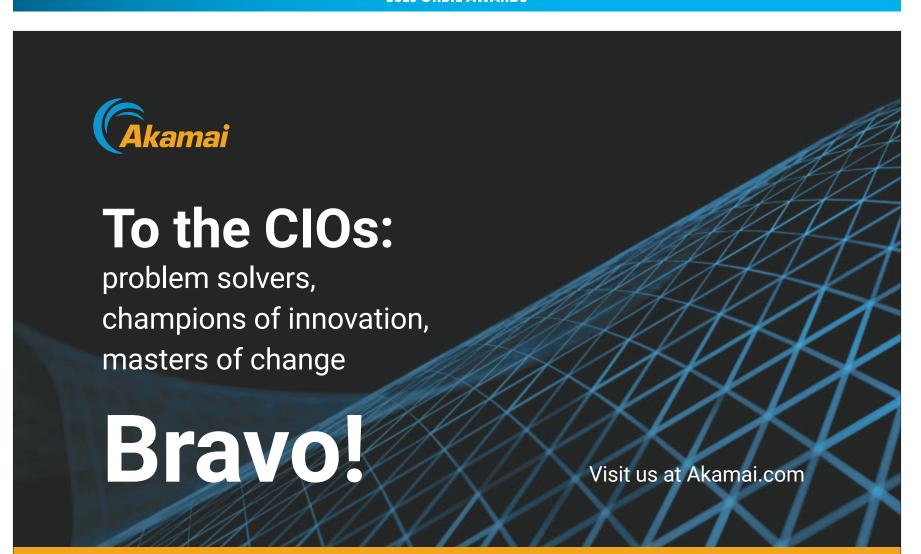

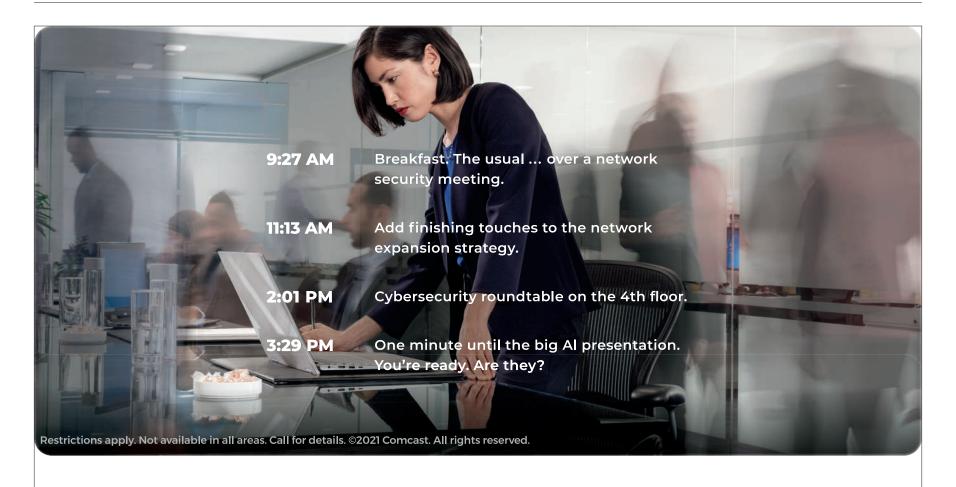

With a reduced remit, we honed our execution and demonstrated the value of our programs. Finally, we created a multi-year investment strategy, including reassessing programs we had stopped, to grow the team by over 150% and add technologies and capabilities."

"Through a multi-vear transformational journey, Global Digital Services accepted the challenge of improving relevance and creating increasing value for Liberty Mutual. We centralized many distributed services to achieve \$47M in cost savings that funded data center modernization. Our on-premise private cloud was launched in 2010. The first public cloud workload was deployed in 2013. DevOps functions supporting developer collaboration and tools came in in 2018. In 2020, we rapidly mobilized to shift 45,000 employees to a full-time WFH model during the pandemic. Now over 70% workloads run in the public cloud and five data centers have been closed globally."

Securely adding thousands of bring your own devices (BYOD) to ensure that we could transition without any interruption in our services to consumers (accident/ road side)."
