Enabling outcomes through technology and innovation

Sheldon Cuffie has tinkered with technology since he was a kid, and his father encouraged him to take televisions and VCRs apart and put them back together. As he grew older and started to plant seeds to build a career, he began with a technical diploma in telecommunications from a U.S. Army technology school.

Cuffie followed that up by earning a B.A. in management and communications from Concordia University and an M.S. in organizational leadership from Quinnipiac University.

Those experiences paved the way for what's now a 25-year career enabling business outcomes through technology and innovation. Cuffie has worked for Kohl's Department Stores, M&I Bank, Abbott Labs, Harley-Davidson Motor Co., Northwestern Mutual, and Dell Technologies. He even ran his own computer business for three years providing technical consulting for small and medium-sized businesses.

Today, Cuffie is enterprise chief information officer at the American Family Insurance Group of companies where he leads the organization's infrastructure, cloud, cybersecurity, digital workplace, technology risk management, and technology business continuity functions across the insurer's group of companies.

His accomplishments have led to him being named the Leadership Award recipient for this year's upcoming Wisconsin ORBIE Awards.

Cuffie joined the insurer in 2019 and was tasked with consolidating the cybersecurity programs across five companies: American Family, CONNECT, The General, Homesite and Main Street America Insurance.

After completing that task with his leadership team in less than 18 months, he began overseeing the company's technology infrastructure, cloud computing and digital workplace functions. He was promoted to his current role in 2022.

Cuffie also is passionate about contributing to the corporate social impact initiatives that drew him to American Family in the first place, according to a recent profile published in Milwaukee Business Journal. Through a partnership with Amazon Web Services, the Milwaukee Tech Hub Coalition and IT services provider Brooksource, the insurer is providing free cloud computing career training to individuals from underrepresented communities in Milwaukee and Southeastern Wisconsin.

He also supports the company's STEAM and Dream program, which provides science, technology, engineering, arts, and math youth education in collaboration with partner organizations including the Milky Way Tech Hub. "We have to immerse youth in technology," Cuffie said. "The earlier we expose them to the benefits of a career in technology, we create the family sustaining jobs and pipelines of talent to enable the innovation and growth that every company is in pursuit of."

Q&A WITH RECIPIENT

Earlier this month, Cuffie shared answered questions about being an IT leader. Here are his answers.

In your role at American Family Insurance what is the most significant impact technology has had in solving key challenges and accelerating business transformation?

Cuffie: Our data scientists' ability to use large data sets to make informed business decisions is a force multiplier

for our business. Artificial intelligence (AI) is gaining public fanfare currently; however, machine learning and AI have been key enablers of critical business decisions at AmFam for many years.

Beyond knowledge of tech applications, what are some of the key traits top IT leaders should develop?

Cuffie: In the Army, everyone has what is called a military occupational specialty (MOS) job code. Logistics specialist, radio operator, truck driver, etc. However, you are trained to be a soldier first. I believe the same is true for technology leaders. Tech leaders are business leaders first, operating in rapidly changing business environments and technology ecosystems of exciting possibilities and frightening risks. "Business technology" leaders have a unique role operating as trusted advisors to a diverse array of stakeholders. This requires developing competencies in negotiation (win-win), listening, political savvy, and organizational agility wrapped in performance orientation supported by emotional intelligence.

How can IT leaders leverage their growing stature in recent years to help their organizations meet evolving employee, consumer and stakeholder expectations?

Technology leaders enable their businesses to meet expectations by generating a customer-first culture. The most successful companies in history with outsized growth are customer obsessed. Through this lens, the employee experience is a key enabler of customer experience. Skilled talent, with an unrelenting curiosity to learn, are highly engaged employees who deliver interactive customer experience. Properly prioritizing and orchestrating the people and technology of an organization in service of the customer is

a proven recipe that pays dividends for all parties.

What opportunities are on the horizon for IT leaders as technologies like AI, the metaverse and the cloud continue to open up new possibilities?

We're living through a historic moment as new technologies rapidly evolve and increase velocity towards mainstream adoption. Supported by companies and my own personal development, I've been fortunate to re-train in IT every few years on one or two new things to maintain my edge and ensure relevance. Now, leaders will need to ramp up experimentation and innovation pods to try out many things at once – every month, every year. Many experiments won't pan out or aren't ready for primetime, but the continuous learning and incremental application will be incredibly valuable.

Please discuss important work the American Family Insurance Group of companies is doing to develop non-traditional talent?

Ironically, statistics indicate that "traditional" students who enter college immediately after high school graduate at approximately 35% after six years. That means the more traditional learner is a working adult who has some education and finishes their education later in life. We are on the hunt for people who have the potential and drive to excel in a technology career but may not have finished school or are underemployed. Our partnership with Amazon Web Services, Brooksource, and the Milwaukee Tech Hub has enabled free cloud-based training in Southeastern Wisconsin. Of the first cohort, six of the students have been contracted to American Family in a variety of cloud engineering roles.
